In accordance with W.Va. Code §8A-7-5, notice is hereby given that the Greenbrier County Commission will meet to conduct public hearings regarding the recommendation to adopt an updated zoning ordinance. Two public hearings will be held: Tuesday, March 3, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. and Wednesday, March 4, 2026 at 11:00 a.m. in the Courtroom of the Greenbrier County Commission, located in the Courthouse Annex at 219 Court Street N, Lewisburg, WV.

Under consideration at the public hearings will be the proposed updated Greenbrier County Zoning Ordinance as recommended by the Greenbrier County Planning Commission.

Summary of proposal: The proposed update reorganizes, clarifies, and modernizes the ordinance text to better reflect current planning practices, applicable state law, and the needs of Greenbrier County; retains the existing zoning districts and existing zoning map; replaces the text of the ordinance to revise definitions, uses, procedures and performance standards.

The study and report on zoning, including the zoning map and proposed replacement zoning ordinance, are available for review in the County Commission office located in the Courthouse, in county public libraries, and are also available for viewing and download on the county website: www.greenbriercounty.net.

Any member of the public may attend and be heard on the matter at the public hearings. Written comments will be accepted and made a part of the record if they are received prior to the close of the hearing on March 4, 2026 by:
